

Benefits for you. And for Sweden.

There are many reasons to do military service. The biggest reason is that you help Sweden continue to be a safe country, but there are also other benefits for you.

- ➔ **Daily compensation**
You receive daily compensation of **SEK146** per day of service, which corresponds to approximately **SEK 4380** per month, tax-free.
- ➔ **Free accommodation and food**
You receive free accommodation and food throughout your conscription.
- ➔ **Education premium**
Upon completion of your training, you will receive a premium equal to the total amount of daily compensation you have already received. For example: if you have completed a nine month training course, **SEK 4,380** is multiplied by nine, which means that your premium will be **SEK 39,420**.
- ➔ **The right to approved leave from studies**
If you have been conscripted, you can apply for approved leave from your studies. You retain your study place and can start or resume your studies after basic training.
- ➔ **Travel to and from home**
Many of the weekends are free and then it is the Swedish Armed Forces that covers the cost of travel to and from your home.
- ➔ **Paid scholastic aptitude tests**
The Swedish Armed Forces will bear the cost of two scholastic aptitude tests if the test days coincide with your basic training.

- ➔ Meet the nurse, doctor and psychologist. Visit the computer room and peek into the rooms with the physical tests. The Mustering Dioramas allow you to experience all the steps of mustering – room by room.

This year you've been given an important task. In this letter you can read about your obligations – and opportunities.

➔ **Your obligations**
If you have received this letter, you must fill in the mustering dossier, which is a questionnaire on rekryteringsmyndigheten.se. You will soon receive a letter with login details. From the time you receive the letter, you have two weeks to respond. We then use your answers to assess whether or not you should be called to mustering. **15,000** of Sweden's 18-year-olds will be called this year. We ensure that those with the right conditions are selected. If you are called, it is your duty to muster.


➔ **Your opportunities**
Basic training with conscription is both a practical and theoretical education. When you complete it, you will grow as a human being and make lifelong memories. **You will develop your collaborative skills, your leadership abilities, and your capacity to perform under stress.** You build up your self-esteem, your fitness and your CV. After basic training, you can go through further training to become an officer, apply for a job in the Swedish Armed Forces, or take your new experiences with you in life and do something completely different.



STEP BY STEP: HOW MUSTERING WORKS ➔

Mustering – step by step

<p>1 Fill in the mustering dossier</p>	<p>The mustering dossier is a questionnaire on our website where we ask questions about your health and physique. We use your answers to assess whether you should be called to mustering. Shortly you will receive a letter from us with login details. Once you receive the letter, you have two weeks to log in and answer the questions. It is your duty to answer truthfully. If you submit deliberately incorrect information, you may be fined.</p> 	<p>4 Enlistment</p>	<p>At the end of the mustering process, you will meet an enlistment officer who matches your conditions with the available positions. Before you return home from mustering, you receive a preliminary message about whether you must do military service, and if so, where. Within a few months of mustering, you will receive your final enlistment decision.</p> 
<p>2 Mustering notification</p>	<p>At the end of March-April you will find out whether or not you will be called to mustering. If you are called, you must come to us. If you are not called, you can apply to try out and have the opportunity to complete basic training with conscription.</p> 	<p>5 Basic training with conscription</p>	<p>If you are admitted to basic training with conscription, your training time will be between 6-15 months. The training can be technically advanced or physically demanding. Or both.</p> <p>6-15 the number of months of basic training depends on the position. The most common is 9 months.</p> <p>There are many different positions – from chef or combat vehicle driver to mine sweeper or mechanic.</p>
<p>3 Muster</p> <p>The mustering process consists of tests, examinations, assessments and interviews. During mustering you will meet with a nurse, a doctor and a psychologist, among others. It takes one to two days to muster and if you need to stay overnight, you stay with us. The results show your conditions for completing a basic training course with conscription.</p> <p>You muster in Stockholm or Malmö.
